Agenda Items:

Department Update: Dr. Sarah Collard discussed the anticipated loss of experienced licensed management staff due to upcoming retirements and the ongoing challenges of recruiting qualified professionals to fill these critical leadership positions.

Crisis Program Review: Dan Bonham provided an overview of the Crisis Program, including historical trends in crisis encounters, program costs, and opportunities to expand community outreach and services.

Siskiyou Village Presentation: Katie Eastman provided an update on the Siskiyou Village Pallet Shelter program, including the installation of new ADA-accessible ramps to improve accessibility for residents. She reported that the program continues to be refined as staff identify opportunities for improvement. Overall, the program has been successful, with many clients benefiting from the stability and support provided through the shelter.

Aegis Treatment Center: Meghan Jones presented information on a new Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) center for individuals with Substance Use Disorder (SUD) opening in Yreka. The facility will initially operate as a satellite office of the Redding location with limited hours, with plans to expand services as community demand increases.

High-Fidelity Wraparound Services: Christine Gannon presented an overview of the new High-Fidelity Wraparound services being implemented within the Children's System of Care program. The presentation

highlighted the program's approach to providing individualized, family-centered support and coordinated care for children and youth with complex behavioral health needs.
