State of California, County of Siskiyou Board of Supervisors Minutes, November 10, 2022

The Honorable Board of Supervisors of Siskiyou County, California, met in special session this 10th day of November 2022; there being present Supervisors Michael N. Kobseff, Nancy Ogren, Ray A. Haupt and Ed Valenzuela, County Administrator Angela Davis, County Counsel Edward J. Kiernan, and County Clerk and ex-Officio Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Laura Bynum by Deputy County Clerk Wendy Winningham. Supervisor Brandon A. Criss participated via teleconference phone from the Butte Valley Community Center, 52900 Highway 97, Dorris CA 96023.

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Valenzuela. Pursuant to AB23, the Clerk announced that the Board was only meeting as the Board of Supervisors and Board members receive no additional compensation. Supervisor Valenzuela led in the salute to the flag of the United States of America.

Presentations from the Public

There were no presentations from the public received.

Community Development Department/Office of Emergency Services - Discussion, direction and possible action re request to ratify Proclamation of a local health emergency by the County Health Officer associated with the health and safety issues caused by the destruction of structures from the 2022 McKinney, Mill and Mountain wildland fires. Corrected Proclamation ratified.

County Administrator Angela Davis provided a brief overview of the request, distributing a corrected version of the Proclamation of a local health emergency by the County Health Officer associated with the health and safety issues caused by the McKinney, Mill and Mountain wildland fires.

In response to County Counsel Edward J. Kiernan, Ms. Davis advised that the document distributed was a corrected version of the document that was posted in the online agenda.

Ms. Davis summarized the typographical errors/corrections found within the fifth and sixth paragraphs of the Proclamation. Ms. Davis further advised that County Health Officer Aaron Stutz, MD had signed a corrected version of the document and requested ratification of the Proclamation.

It was moved by Supervisor Haupt and seconded by Supervisor Kobseff to ratify for approval the subject proclamation of local health emergency by the County Health Officer associated with the health and safety issues caused by the destruction of structures from the 2022 McKinney, Mill and Mountain wildland fires, as corrected.

Following brief discussion between Ms. Davis and Deputy County Clerk Wendy Winningham regarding the need to reaffirm the Proclamation every 30 days and the Community Development Department's responsibility to bring that agenda item before the Board of Supervisors, the Vice Chair called for the vote. Following a roll call vote with Supervisors Haupt, Kobseff, Ogren, Valenzuela and Criss voting YES, the motion carried unanimously.

Adjournment - There being no further business to come before the Board of Supervisors, the meeting was adjourned.
