A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YREKA
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND
RECOVERY FOR THE ILLEGAL DISPOSAL SITE ABATEMENT GRANT
PROGRAM, DESIGNATING AUTHORIZED SIGNATURE AUTHORITIES,
AND ADOPTION OF A CLASS 30 CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION FROM THE

WHEREAS, the City of Yreka owns four contiguous parcels (APNs 062-161-140, 062-161-170, 062-161-160, and 062-161-130) totaling approximately 454,127 square feet (10.4 acres) adjacent to Greenhorn Reservoir in southeast Yreka; and

WHEREAS, these City-owned parcels have been severely impacted by an unauthorized homeless encampment housing an estimated 50 individuals at any given time, resulting in extensive contamination with hazardous materials including human waste, needles and syringes, batteries, propane tanks, and drug paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, the contaminated site poses urgent threats to public health, safety, and the environment, including biohazard exposure for encampment residents and City workers, contamination of the protected Greenhorn Reservoir watershed, wildfire ignition and spread risk on sloped terrain, and strain on City emergency and public works resources; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) offers the Solid Waste Disposal and Codisposal Site Cleanup Grant Program, Illegal Disposal Site Abatement, providing funding to clean up solid waste sites where the responsible party either cannot be identified or is unwilling or unable to pay for timely remediation and where cleanup is needed to protect public health and safety and/or the environment; and

WHEREAS, no responsible party for the unauthorized waste disposal can be identified or located, and the City's General Fund cannot absorb the estimated \$242,727.00 cost for professional hazardous waste remediation; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for CalRecycle's Illegal Disposal Site Abatement Grant Program, Application Cycle 104 (SWC104), Fiscal Year 2025-26, requesting grant funds in the amount of \$242,727.00 to contract with qualified professional environmental cleanup services to remediate the site; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will include hazardous waste removal, solid waste cleanup, biohazard disinfection, site sanitization, and preparation for future recreational use and habitat restoration; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted an Environmentally Preferable Purchasing and Practices (EPPP) Policy as required by CalRecycle; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project was evaluated for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and found to be exempt pursuant to a Class 30 "Minor Actions to Prevent, Stabilize, Mitigate or Eliminate the Release of Threat of Release of Hazardous Waste or Hazardous Substances" Categorical Exemption, Section 15330 of the CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, California Labor Code section 1782 does not prohibit the City of Yreka from receiving state funds for this project; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Yreka and its residents to pursue this grant funding to eliminate public health, safety, and environmental hazards while restoring valuable public lands for community benefit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Yreka as follows:

SECTION 1. GRANT APPLICATION AUTHORIZATION

The City Council hereby authorizes and directs City staff to submit a grant application to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for the Solid Waste Disposal and Codisposal Site Cleanup Grant Program, Illegal Disposal Site Abatement, Application Cycle 104 (SWC104), Fiscal Year 2025-26, requesting grant funds in the amount of \$242,726 for the Greenhorn Reservoir Encampment Cleanup Project.

SECTION 2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The grant-funded project shall include:

- a) Professional hazardous waste removal including human waste, needles/syringes, batteries, propane tanks, and drug paraphernalia across 454,127 square feet;
- b) Solid waste removal and debris cleanup with recycling of recoverable materials;
- c) Application of EPA-registered anti-microbial agents to 454,127 square feet for biohazard disinfection and site sanitization:
- d) Proper manifesting, transportation, and disposal of all waste at permitted facilities;
- e) All work performed in compliance with OSHA, EPA, CalEPA, and City standards.

SECTION 3. SIGNATURE AUTHORITY

The City Council hereby designates the following position(s) as Signature Authorities authorized to sign all grant-related documents necessary to secure funds and implement the approved project, including but not limited to grant applications, grant agreements, amendments, payment requests, progress reports, final reports, and all other documents required for grant administration:

- a) City Manager
- b) Assistant City Manager
- b) Finance Director

SECTION 4. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The Signature Authorities identified in Section 3 are hereby authorized to delegate their signature authority to the following position(s) by executing a Letter of Designation:

- a) City Manager
- b) Assistant City Manager
- b) Finance Director

Such delegation shall be documented in writing through a Letter of Designation signed by the delegating Signature Authority and submitted to CalRecycle prior to the designee's exercise of signature authority.

SECTION 5. GRANT AGREEMENT EXECUTION

If the City is awarded grant funds, the City Manager or designated Signature Authority is hereby authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with CalRecycle and to take all actions necessary to implement the approved project in compliance with all grant agreement terms and conditions.

SECTION 6. FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS

The City Council acknowledges and commits to the following:

- a) The City will provide in-kind contributions valued at approximately \$15,000 in the form of project management, site inspections, agency coordination, and administrative support;
- b) The City will be responsible for any project costs exceeding the grant award amount;
- c) The City will comply with all grant agreement payment, reporting, and documentation requirements;
- d) The City will complete the project within the grant term ending June 30, 2028.

SECTION 7. COST RECOVERY WAIVER REQUEST

The City Council hereby requests that CalRecycle waive cost recovery requirements for this project based on the following factors consistent with CalRecycle's cost recovery policy:

- a) The properties are publicly owned by the City of Yreka and maintained for public benefit and use;
- b) No responsible party for the unauthorized waste disposal can be identified or located;
- c) The City did not cause the disposal of waste on the properties;
- d) The City will not gain financial benefit from the cleanup beyond restoration of public lands for community welfare;

e) The site will be used for public recreation, conservation, and watershed protection following remediation.

SECTION 8. POST-REMEDIATION COMMITMENTS

Following completion of the grant-funded project, the City commits to:

- a) Installing and maintaining physical barriers and signage to prevent re-encampment;
- b) Conducting regular site inspections and providing rapid response to unauthorized access or dumping;
- c) Implementing code enforcement follow-up in coordination with the Yreka Police Department;
- d) Providing long-term site management to protect the public investment in remediation;
- e) Pursuing future phases of recreational development and habitat restoration.

SECTION 9. CEQA COMPLIANCE

The City Council hereby finds that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15330, Class 30 Categorical Exemption "Minor Actions to Prevent, Minimize, Stabilize, Mitigate or Eliminate the Release of Threat of Release of Hazardous Waste or Hazardous Substances" and directs staff to file a Notice of Exemption.

SECTION 11. ENVIRONMENTALLY PREFERABLE PURCHASING AND PRACTICES POLICY

The City Council hereby confirms that the City has adopted an Environmentally Preferable Purchasing and Practices (EPPP) Policy as required by CalRecycle.

SECTION 12. DURATION OF AUTHORITY

The authorizations granted in this Resolution shall remain in effect through the completion of the grant term ending June 30, 2028, or until superseded by subsequent action of the City Council.

SECTION 13. CERTIFICATION

The City Clerk is hereby directed to certify to the adoption of this Resolution and to provide certified copies to CalRecycle and to City staff as needed for grant application and administration purposes.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
