

OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR COMMERCIAL LILY BULB OPERATIONS IN THE SMITH RIVER PLAIN

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (North Coast Water Board), as lead agency, has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for waste discharge requirements regulating the discharge of waste from commercial lily bulb operations in the Smith River Plain, "General Waste Discharge Requirements for Commercial Lily Bulb Operations in the Smith River Plain" (Lily Bulb Order). The Draft EIR is available for public review and comment.

The public review period for the Draft EIR is from January 30, 2026, until March 16, 2026. During the public review period, the North Coast Water Board will receive written comments on the Draft EIR. Also, during the public review period, North Coast Water Board will hold a public workshop on the Draft EIR and Draft Lily Bulb Order during its February Board meeting (February 18, 2026, with an expected start time of 4pm) at the Elk Valley Rancheria Sam Lopez Community Room, 2332 Howland Hill Road, Crescent City, CA 95531 and via Zoom. The North Coast Water Board is expected to consider certification of a Final EIR and adoption of a proposed Lily Bulb Order at its August Board meeting (August 5th or 6th) at a location to be determined and via Zoom. The agenda will be posted online (with instructions for joining via Zoom) 10 days prior to both meetings and will indicate the meeting start time and instructions on how to provide oral comments.

The proposed project (Lily Bulb Order) is the issuance of a permit regulating waste discharges from commercial lily bulb operations in the Smith River Plain. The purpose of the Lily Bulb Order is to protect and restore beneficial uses and achieve water quality objectives specified in the North Coast Basin Plan.
