An investigation was conducted to address allegation regarding fruit flies infestation and flies at produce area, specifically location of bananas. The following observations were found:</p> <p>5, 12) Observed numerous spoiled produce (onions, potatoes, papayas, grapefruits, apples, tomatoes, limes, squash, etc.) that are overly ripped or rotten throughout the produce area (front and back sections). Per operator, produce are normally inspected before being offered/displayed for sale. Produce are not inspected once it is on the sales floor unless an issue is observed, like excessive fruit flies congregating in a certain area. Ensure all foods offered for consumers' consumption are pure and unadulterated. Practice inspecting displayed produce more frequently or as needed. All produce were inspected and overly ripped produce were voluntarily discarded.</p> <p>13, 14) Observed food waste and fruit juice buildup on the bottom of produce containers in sales area. Ensure equipment are routinely cleaned as to not attract or harbor insects. Facility were washing and cleaning food shelves and attached accessories with soap, water, and Mineral Oils during inspection.</p> <p>25) Observed an infestation of fruit flies and numerous flies in the produce area and warehouse area where produce waste and mop sinks are located. Per operator, produce waste are disposed of at least once a day. Ensure waste are disposed of in a sanitary manner and is removed at a frequency as to not attract insects, vermin, and or rodents or create a nuisance or public health concern. Eliminate potential food sources and breeding areas. <u>A reinspection will be conducted in 3 days.</u></p>
