The following are observations noted:</p> <p>1, 2) Observed a pot of yogurt stored in the walk-in cooler at 65F. Per operator, yogurt is made by allowing heated milk mixture to ferment over night in ambient temperature on the prep table. Hold dairy at 45F or colder at all times. Unless food is held hot at 135F or hotter, it must be rapidly cooled and held. Manufacturing milk product requires a state license with CDFA. Discontinue production of all yogurt products until a permit is obtained. Voluntarily discarded.</p> <p>2) 5th Notice - Observed a bowl used to portion food from bulk. Utilize scoop with handle to portion food and store scoop in the food with handle above the food. COS.</p> <p>14) Observed a new deli cooler in the kitchen and reach-in cooler in customer self-service area installed without pre-approval. Ensure all equipment are pre-approved by this department prior to installation. Submit manufacturer spec sheets to this dept. asap.</p> <p>14) 4th Notice - Observed the non-ANSI certified ROVSUN food warmer still in use after numerous written documentation since 2024 to discontinue use. <u>Discontinue use immediately</u> and replace with ANSI certified equipment. If equipment is replaced, again, submit manufacturer spec sheets to this department prior to installation.</p> <p>17) 4th Notice - Observed empty hand soap and paper towel dispensers at handwashing station. The hand soap dispenser appears to be damaged. Facility is using another handwash station that is approx. 50ft from the cook line area. It is shared with multiple food facilities and is not easily accessible or convenient for use. Maintain warm water, hand soap and paper towels in dispenser at all times and in good repair. <u>Repair and correct immediately.</u></p> <p>20) Facility was not able to produce a copy of Food Manager Certificate during inspection. Ensure all certificates (food manager and handler) are available to be viewed when request during inspection. Correct immediately.</p> <p>A reinspection fee is assessed for non-compliance and repeat violations.
