Hold all hot food @ 135 degrees F or hotter. Voluntarily discarded.</p> <p>1) Observed numerous deli meats held in the deli prep cooler @ 45-49 degrees F. Hold all cold food @ 41 degrees F or colder. Correct immediately.</p> <p>9) Observed buildup of dust or dirt above the ceiling and compressor shields in the walk-in refrigerator at deli section. Observed spoiled food on the floor in produce walk-in refrigerator. Maintain equipment in a cleanly manner at all times. Correct ASAP.</p> <p>14) 2nd Notice- Observed heat lamps missing from the hot holding table. This resulted in the above foods failing to remain hot during holding. Ensure all equipment are fully functional and in good repair at all times. Corrected during inspection.</p> <p>14) Observed parts deli prep cooler not sufficiently holding food to temp. Observed excessive dust buildup on the compressor that is hindering air flow. Ensure that this equipment is fully functional and in good repair at all times. Correct ASAP.</p> <p>13) Observed food buildup on the bbq grill at front parking lot. The staff stated the bbq was last used two days ago. Ensure equipment is cleaned after use to prevent harboring or attracting insects, rodent, and other contaminants. Wash, clean, and sanitize asap.</p> <p>3) 2nd Notice- Observed boxes of food stored on the floor of all the walk-in refrigeration units. Ensure that all food is stored at least 6" off the ground. Correct immediately.</p> <p>10) 2nd Notice- Observed no thermometer available to measure the foods held under the heat lamps. Obtain a thermometer immediately and ensure that all foods are survey multiple times per day to ensure that they don't enter the danger zone. The danger zone is between 42-134 degrees F.</p> <p>20) 2nd Notice- Facility was unable to provide food handler cards of all employees when requested during inspection. All employees are required to obtain a food handlers card within 30 days of hire. Correct immediately and maintain copies onsite.</p> <p>Future non-compliance will result in reinspection fees, administrative hearing, and potential permit revocation.</p>
