Flood Control and Water Conservation District Minutes

The Honorable Directors of the Flood Control and Water Conservation District of Siskiyou County, California, met in regular session this 8th day of July 2025; there being present Directors Jess Harris, Ed Valenzuela, Michael N. The meeting was called to order by Chair Ogren.

Public Comment

There were no public comments received.

Flood Control and Water Conservation District - Approve an emergency update in accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 22050 for emergency repair and replacement to the General Store main office and roof. Affirm by 4/5 vote the emergency declaration remains necessary and authorize staff to proceed with needed repairs at the facility.

Deputy Director of General Services Jessica Skillen appeared before the District Board and provided an update on the Lake Siskiyou Campground General Store repairs.

Director Kobseff suggested making improvements at the Lake Siskiyou Campground water well and boat ramp with an item coming back before the District Board.

It was moved by Director Valenzuela, seconded by Director Kobseff and carried, following a roll call vote with Directors Valenzuela, Haupt, Harris, Kobseff and Ogren voting YES, to approve an emergency update in accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 22050 for emergency repair and replacement to the General Store main office and roof and affirm by 4/5 vote the emergency declaration remains necessary and authorize staff to proceed with needed repairs at the facility.
