PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project consists of nine livestock watering systems to be improved or constructed. Each system is within farmed fields and farmsteads; comprising 1 acre each. All systems will be limited to small trenches, gravel pads and troughs, well drilling, pump and power installation and storage tanks. Benefits will be to environmental instream fishery values.

REASONS PROJECT IS EXEMPT

Public Resources Code, Division 13, Chapter 6, Article 19, Section 15304 allows minor alteration of vegetation. Minimal ground disturbance is expected from this project. A current CNDDB and USFWS search was conducted. The project as proposed will not have a negative impact upon any listed species of plant or animal with potential to be found within the project area. This project as proposed is not expected to result in a significant impact on the environment with benefits to instream fisheries. No state agency permits are needed. There will be Siskiyou County well drilling permits required. Alternative stock watering will allow landowners to voluntarily leave water in stream during critical periods and low flow conditions.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SHASTA VALLEY
RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT**

RESOLUTION 25- 009

June 18th, 2025

WHEREAS the Siskiyou County Farm Bureau has received grant funding from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, (CDFW) for the *Securing Water Supply for Salmon and Agriculture in the Scott and Shasta Rivers Project*;

WHEREAS, *Securing Water Supply for Salmon and Agriculture in the Scott and Shasta Rivers Project* is being implemented to support instream flows during natural droughts and State of California Emergency Curtailment periods by improving alternative livestock watering facilities;

WHEREAS, Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District has the legal authority and is authorized to enter into a funding agreement as a contractor for administrative services with the Siskiyou County Farm Bureau; and

WHEREAS, Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District proposes to oversee all aspects of stock water planning, contracting and implementation in the Shasta River valley and Siskiyou County including project planning and management, environmental documentation planning and development planning,

WHEREAS, Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District, acting as lead agency for environmental compliance will complete all required steps for CEQA, file all necessary permits and clearances;

WHEREAS, Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District Board has analyzed the project actions and determined that the activity in question is exempt from CEQA under Article 19, Sections 15304 of the CEQA Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the SVRCD in session assembled on June 18, 2025, based on the evidence presented, both written and oral, hereby adopts the Notice of Exemption for the modification of the *Securing Water Supply for Salmon and Agriculture in the Scott and Shasta Rivers Project*. The project includes work that is funded by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. This determination is based on the following findings and for the following reasons:


1. Based on the entire record, the SVRCD Board of Directors finds that the project is Categorically Exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15304, as the project entails minor modifications to existing agricultural structures and lands.
2. The staff of the SVRCD is hereby directed to promptly file a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the Siskiyou County Clerk.

3. The Board of Directors of the SVRCD hereby authorizes the District Administrator to execute the Notice of Exemption on behalf of the SVRCD.
